



Les nombres avec French Topics & Co Je compte: 1, 2, 3.....10, 20

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Vingt (20), trente (30) quarante (40) cinquante (50) soixante (60) soixante-dix (70), quatre-vingt (80), quatre-vingt dix (90), cent (100), mille (1000), un million (1000000)

Tips:

There is no word for "eighty" in standard French, instead 80 is *quatre-vingt*, literally four-twenties (think "four-score"). 81 is *quatre-vingt-un* (four-twenty-one), 82 is *quatre-vingt-deux* (four-twenty-two), and so on, all the way up to 89.

There's no word for ninety either, so you continue using *quatre-vingt* and adding from ten. 90 is *quatre-vingt-dix* (four-twenty-ten), 91 is *quatre-vingt-onze* (four-twenty-eleven), etc.

Be careful with the pronunciation of **deux** and **trois**. When you say them in front of a word that starts with a vowel, you need to say an extra 'z' sound – e.g. *deux enfants* is pronounced *deux zenfants*, and *trois éclairs* is pronounced *trois zéclairs*.
